


A river is a ribbon-like body of water that flows downhill from the force of gravity.


Ocean



The ocean is a huge body of saltwater that covers about 71 percent of Earth's surface.



Lake is any relatively large body of slowly moving or standing water that occupies an inland basin of appreciable size.



Valley




A low area of land between hills or mountains, typically with a river or stream flowing through it.

Island



An island is a body of land surrounded by water.

Desert



A desert is a barren area of landscape where little precipitation occurs and, consequently, living conditions are hostile for plant and animal life.

Jungle



A jungle is land covered with dense forest and tangled vegetation, usually in tropical climates.





A hill is a piece of land that rises higher than everything surrounding it. It looks like a little bump in the Earth.

Volcano




A volcano is an opening in the earth's crust through which lava, volcanic ash, and qases escape.

Waterfall



A waterfall is a point in a river or stream where water flows over a vertical drop or a series of steep drops.

Plain



A plain is a flat expanse of land that generally does not change much in elevation, and is primarily treeless.
